

Connecting Jasmine Smart to Google Home

Applies To: All Wi-Fi enabled Jasmine Smart devices (Switches, Plugs, Lights, Thermostats)

1. Introduction

This manual provides step-by-step instructions for integrating your Jasmine Smart home devices with the Google Home ecosystem. By connecting your Jasmine Smart account to Google Home, you can control your appliances using Google Assistant voice commands and manage all your smart devices from a single centralized interface.

2. Prerequisites

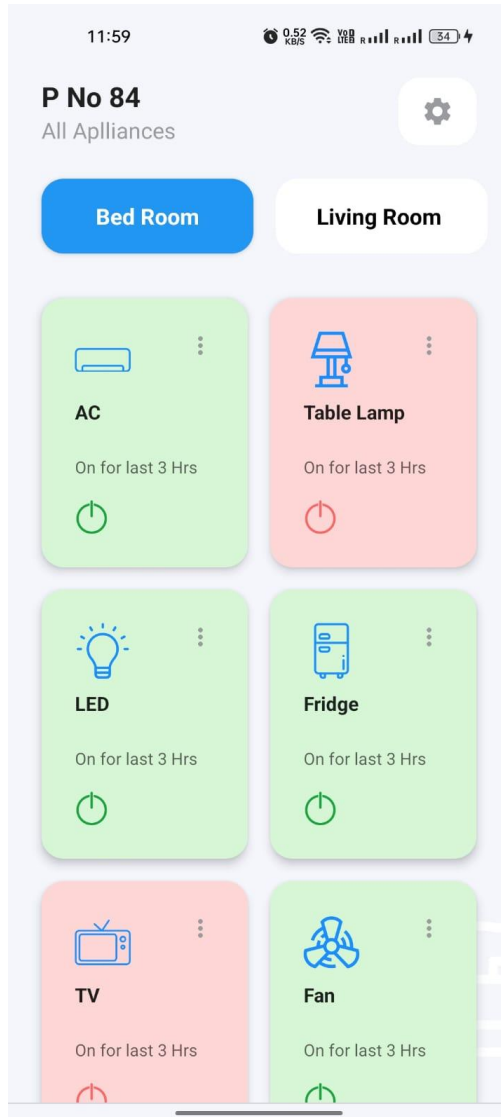
Before beginning the integration process, please ensure you have the following:

- A stable 2.4GHz Wi-Fi internet connection (5GHz is generally not supported for initial device pairing).
- A fully set up and powered-on Jasmine Smart device.
- A smartphone or tablet (iOS or Android) connected to your Wi-Fi network.
- The **Jasmine Smart** app installed with an active account and your device(s) already added and working.
- The **Google Home** app installed and logged in with your active Google account.
- A Google Assistant-enabled device (e.g., Google Nest Mini, Nest Hub, or just your smartphone).

3. Step-by-Step Integration Guide

Phase 1: Verify Jasmine Smart Setup

1. Open the **Jasmine Smart** app on your smartphone

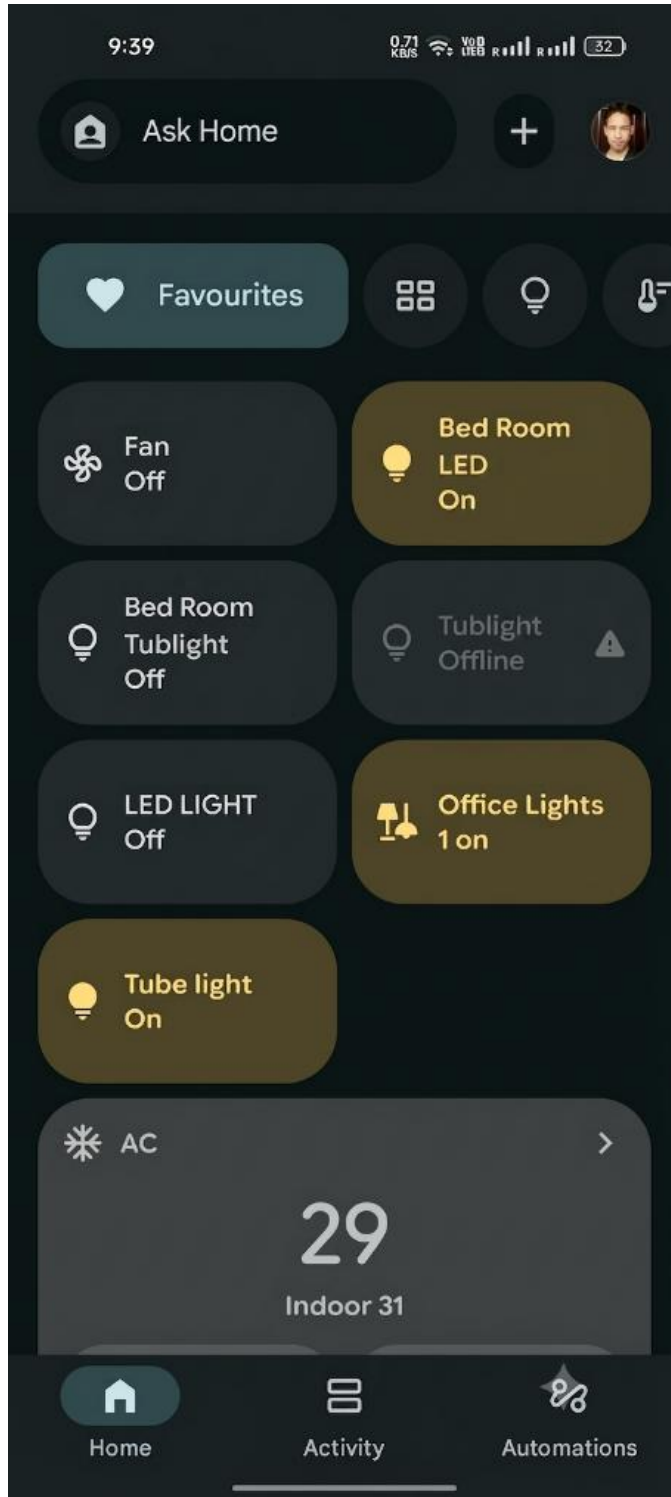


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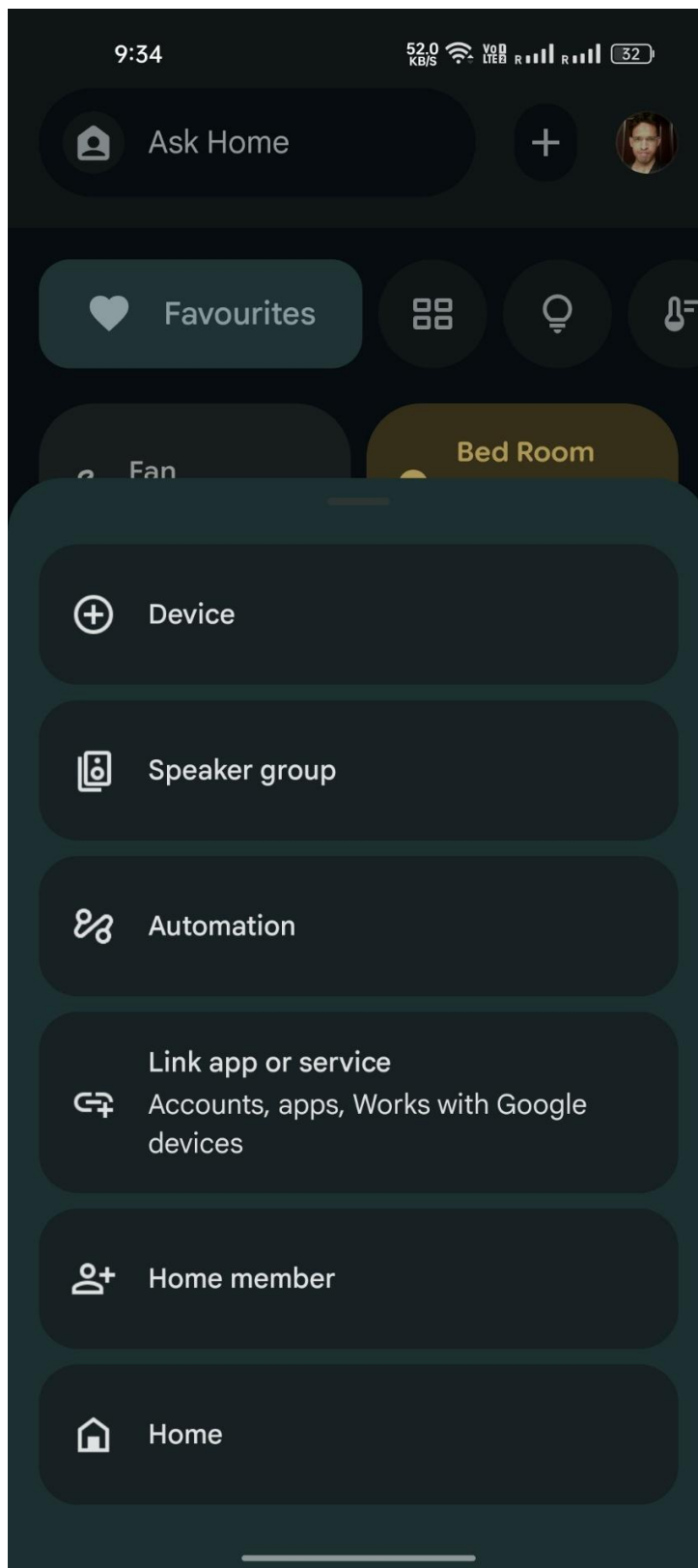
2. Ensure your smart device (e.g., Smart Switch, Camera, or Thermostat) is listed on the home screen.
3. Test the device by toggling it ON and OFF via the Jasmine Smart app.
4. **Important:** Make sure the device is assigned a clear, easily recognizable name (e.g., "Living Room Fan" or "Kitchen Light"). This is the name Google Assistant will use for voice commands.

Phase 2: Link to Google Home

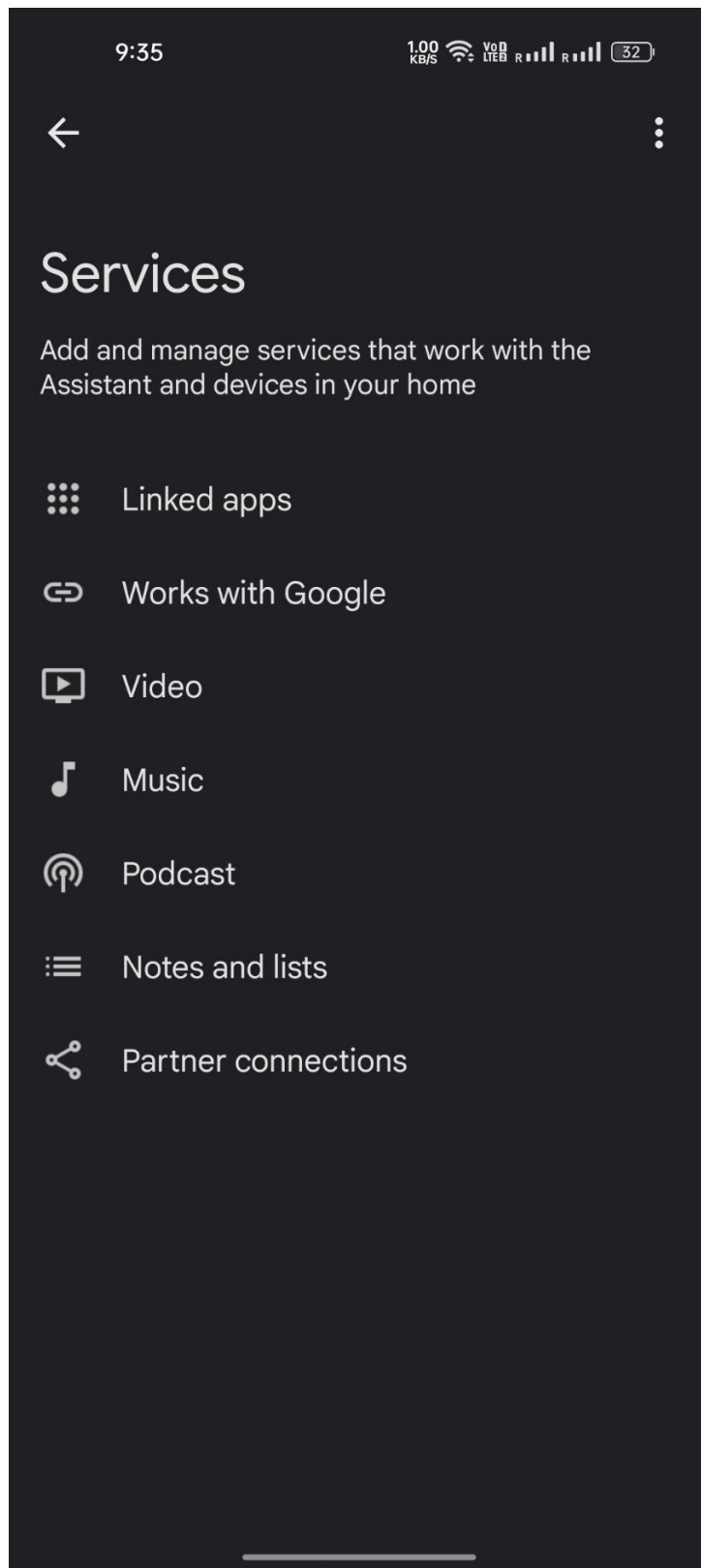
1. Open the **Google Home** app on your smartphone.
2. Tap the **"+" (Plus) icon** in the top-left corner of the screen.



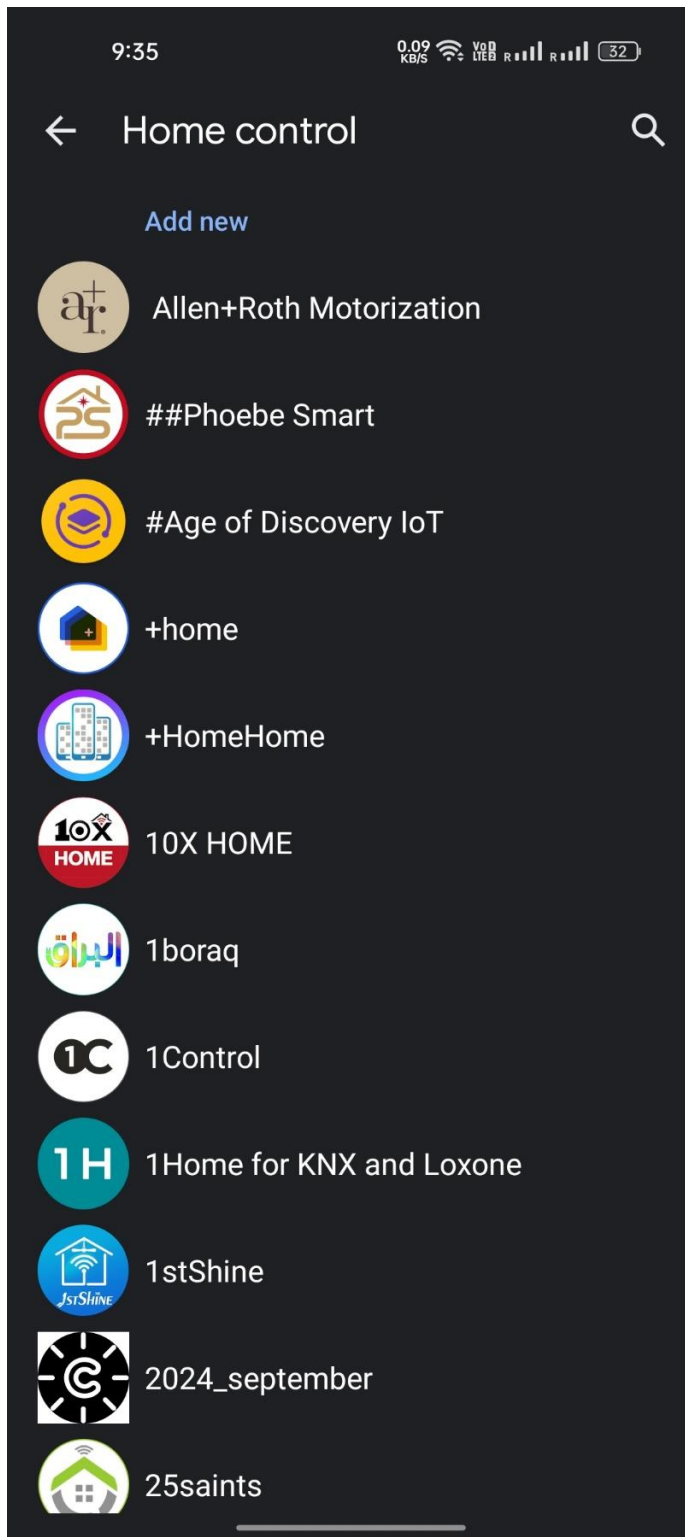
3. Select "Link app or service"



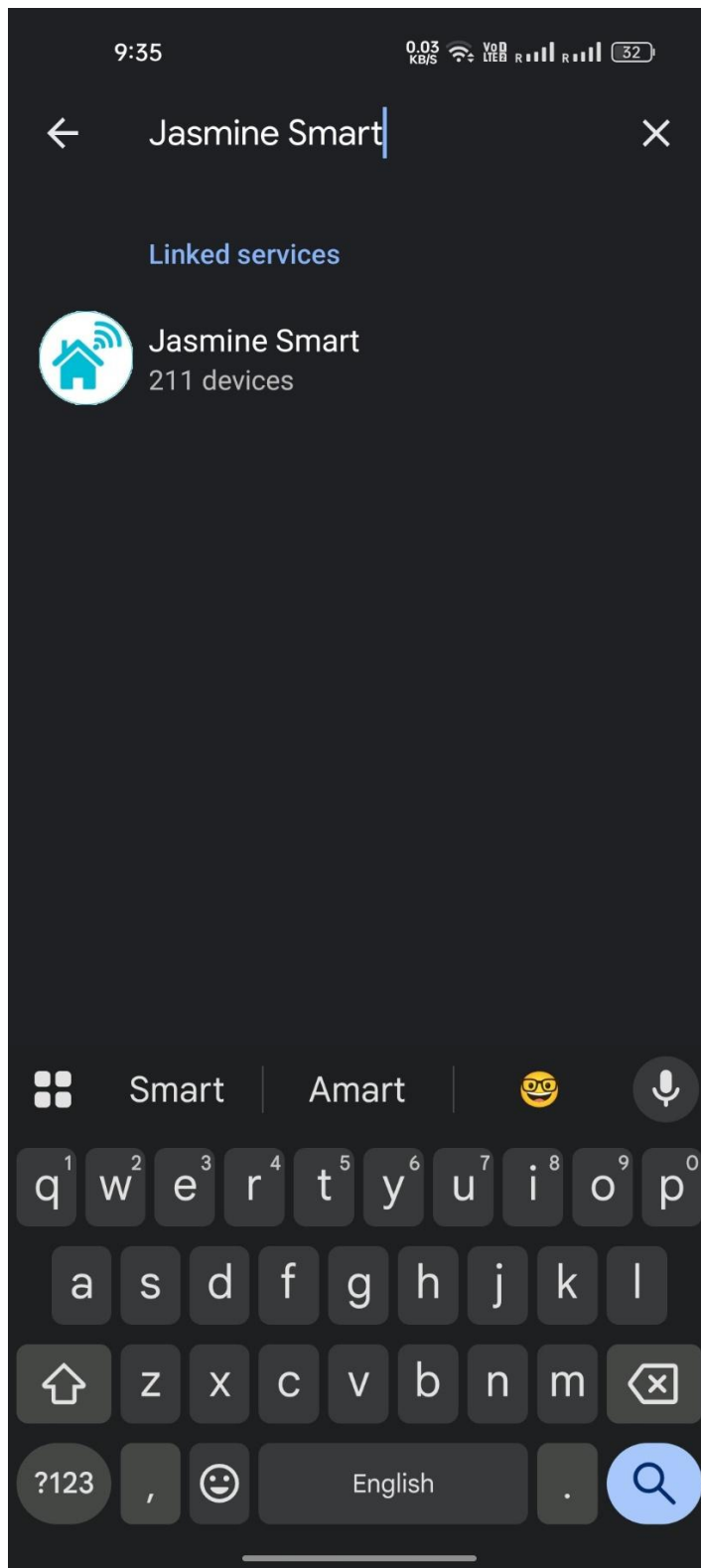
4. Select the **"Works with Google"**.



5. You will see a list of available integrations. Tap the **Search icon** (magnifying glass) in the top-right corner.

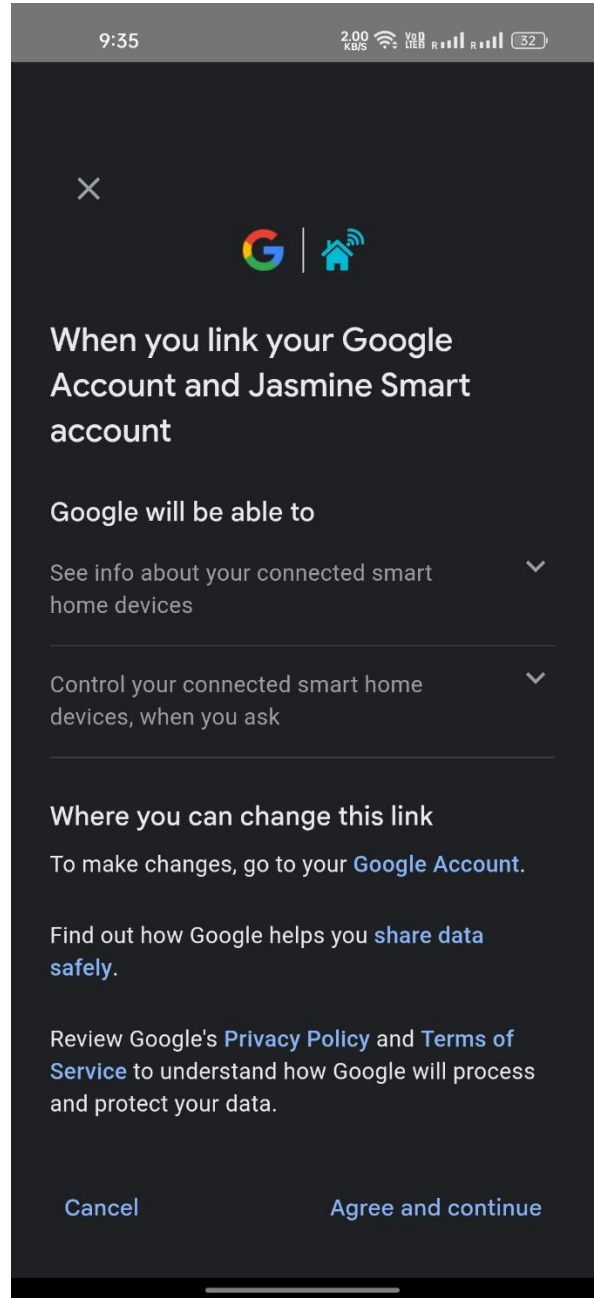
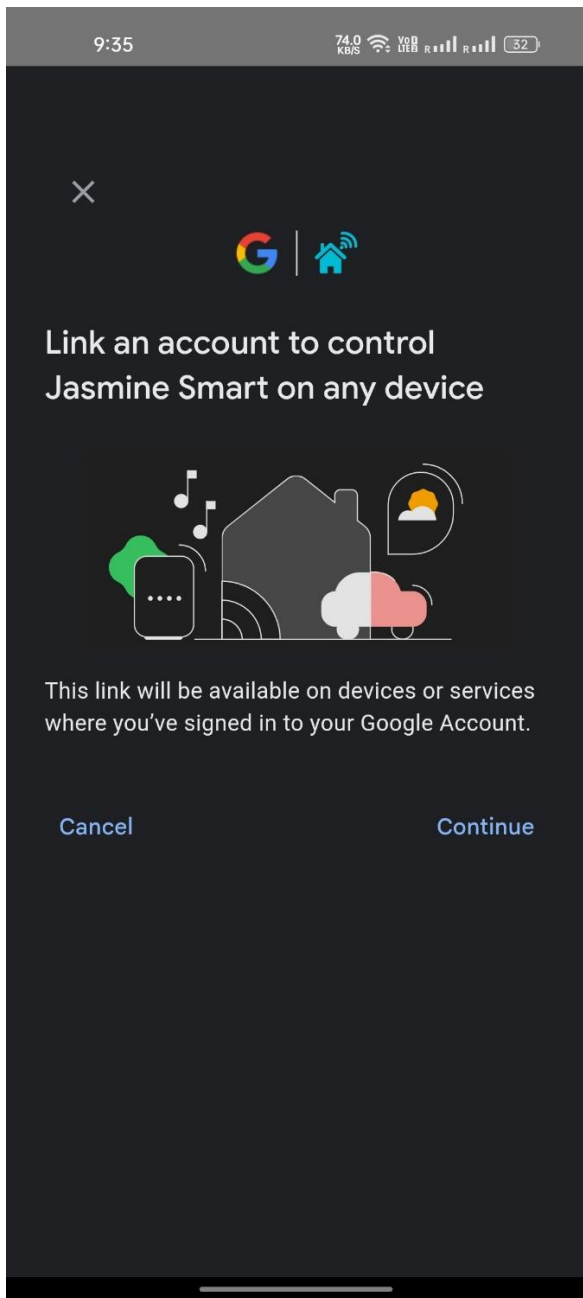


6. Type "**Jasmine Smart**" into the search bar.

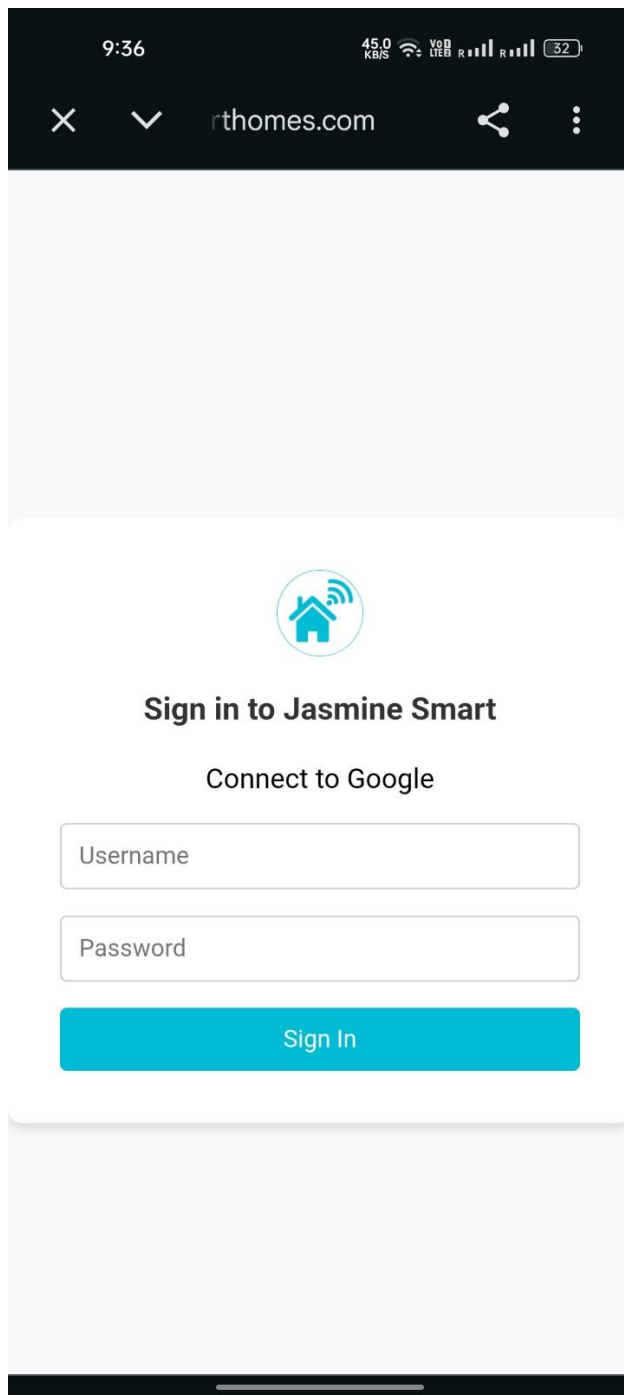


7. Select **Jasmine Smart** from the search results.

8. Click **“Continue”** and then Click **“Agree and continue”**.



9. You will be redirected to a secure login page. Enter the username (email or phone number) and password associated with your **Jasmine Smart** account.

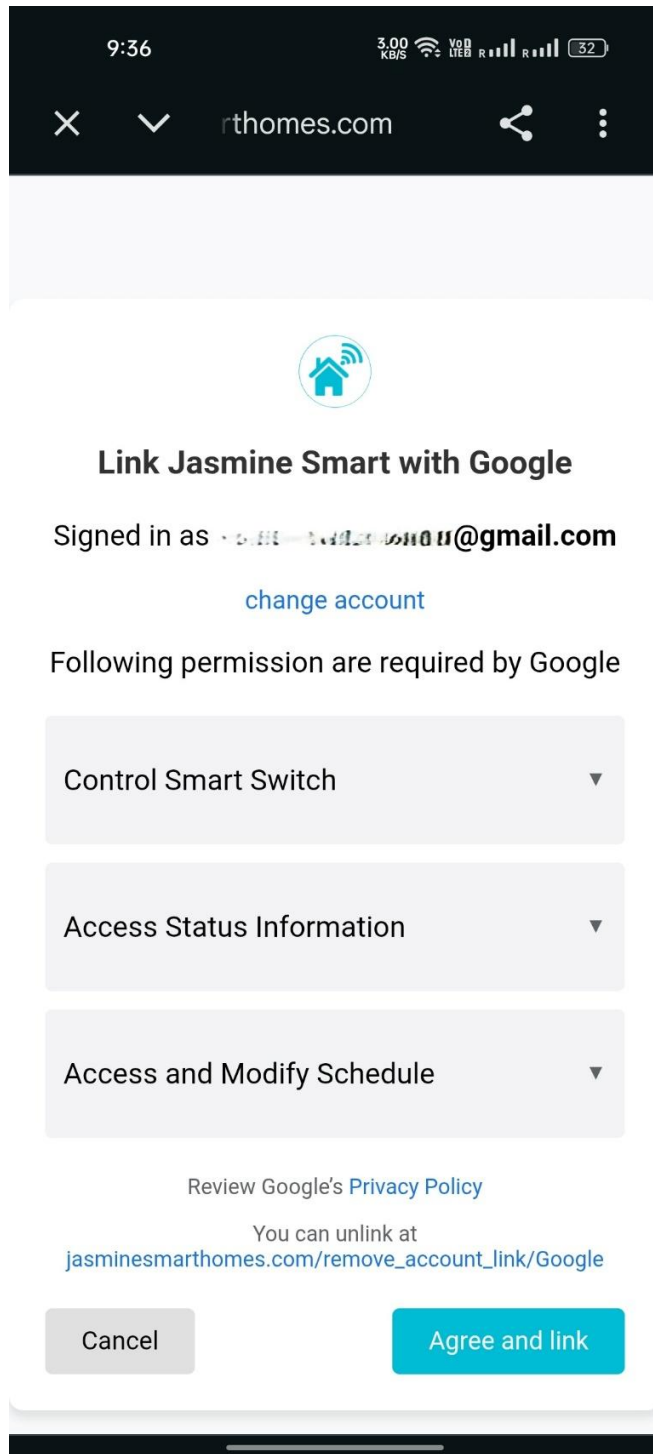

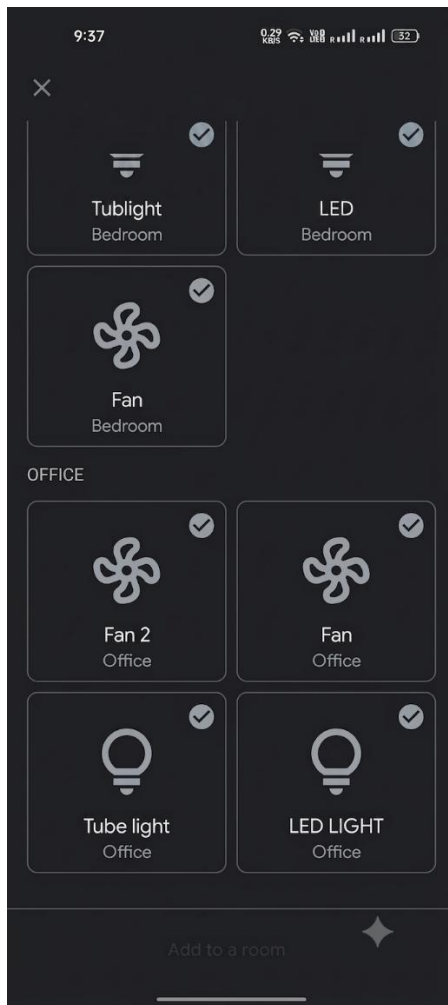

10. Tap **"Agree and Link"** to grant Google Home permission to access your Jasmine Smart devices.



Phase 3: Assign Devices to Rooms

1. Once successfully linked, the Google Home app will display a list of your Jasmine Smart devices.



2. Select a device and tap **"Next"**.
3. Choose the home where the device is located and tap **"Next"**.
4. Assign the device to a specific room (e.g., Bedroom, Kitchen, Garage) to help organize your Google Home ecosystem.
5. Repeat this process for any other newly discovered Jasmine Smart devices.

4. Voice Command Guide

Once setup is complete, you can use your Google Assistant to control your home. Start your command with "Hey Google" or "OK Google", followed by your request:

Basic Controls:

- *"Hey Google, turn on the [Device Name]."* (e.g., "turn on the Living Room Light")

Lighting & Thermostats (If applicable):

- *"Hey Google, dim the [Device Name] to 50%."*
- *"Hey Google, set the [Thermostat Name] to 22 degrees."*

Checking Status:

- *"Hey Google, is the [Device Name] on?"*

5. Troubleshooting & Support

If you encounter issues during or after the setup process, refer to the following solutions:

- **Google Home cannot find Jasmine Smart:** Ensure your Google Home app is updated to the latest version. Double-check your spelling when searching for the integration.
- **Authorization Failed:** Verify that you are using the correct login credentials for the Jasmine Smart app. Reset your Jasmine Smart password if necessary.
- **Device not responding to voice commands:**
 1. Check your Wi-Fi connection.
 2. Try saying, *"Hey Google, sync my devices"* to refresh the connection between Google Home and the Jasmine Smart servers.
- **Device shows as "Offline" in Google Home:** Open the Jasmine Smart app directly to see if the device is online there. If it is offline in the native app, check the device's power source and your home router.

How to Unlink and Relink (Factory Reset Connection)

If devices stop syncing entirely, relinking the account often resolves the issue:

1. Open Google Home > Tap "+" > Set up device > Have something already set up?
2. Find **Jasmine Smart** under "Linked services".
3. Tap it and select **Unlink account**.
4. Repeat the steps in **Phase 2** to link the account again.
